

Off-licence Sections 17 to 20 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

67/OFF/12/2024

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Wild Earth Wines Limited** is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at 180 State Highway 8B, Cromwell and known as the The Stoaker Room Cromwell, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- b) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Sunday - 9.00am to 10.00pm

- c) Alcohol may only be delivered Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00pm.
- d) Each of the following parts of the premises is designated as a **Supervised** area: Bar area
- e) The premises are shown on the plan submitted to the District Licensing Committee dated 27 November 2023.
- f) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- a) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the carpark is designated as the principal entrance.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue.
- If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

Expiry date being 12 February 2025 unless renewed for a further period.
